





PLASTISOL IS USED AS INK FOR SCREEN-PRINTING ON TO TEXTILES.
PLASTISOLS ARE THE MOST COMMONLY USED INKS FOR PRINTING
DESIGNS ON TO GARMENTS, AND ARE PARTICULARLY USEFUL FOR
PRINTING OPAQUE GRAPHICS ON DARK FABRICS AND BLENDED
GARMENTS. PLASTISOL INKS ARE NOT WATER-SOLUBLE.







PLASTISOL IS BEST USED WHEN THE CUSTOMER WANTS THE MOST CONSISTENT/VIBRANT PRINT WITHOUT FADING. ESPECIALLY ON BLENDED GARMENTS.



OUR SPECIAL HYBRID INK IS A PERFECT BLEND OF WATER BASED AND PLASTISOL INKS. HYBRID INK ALLOWS FOR THE CONSITENCY OF PLASTISOL INKS WHILE ALSO CREATING A SOFTER PRINT SIMILAR TO WATER BASE AND DISCHARGE INKS.

INSTEAD OF SITTING ON TOP OF IT. THIS PROCESS CREATES A VERY SOFT/VINTAGE FEEL TO THE PRINT. COMMONLY USED ON DARKER GARMENTS.

DISCHARGE INKS ARE BEST USED ON DARKER GARMENTS NEEDING A SOFT / VINTAGE PRINT.

* PRINTING DISCHARGE INKS ON BLENDED GARMENTS WILL CAUSE EXTREME DISTRESSING AND INCONSISTENCIES WITH YOUR PRINT



WATER BASED INK IS A DECORATIVE INK THAT SOAKS INTO THE FABRIC INSTEAD OF SITTING ON TOP OF IT. THIS PROCESS CREATES A VERY SOFT/VINTAGE FEEL TO THE PRINT. COMMONLY USED ON LIGHTER GARMENTS.

WATER-BASED INKS ARE BEST USED ON LIGHTER GARMENTS NEEDING A SOFT / VINTAGE PRINT.

* PRINTING WATER-BASED INKS ON BLENDED GARMENTS WILL CAUSE EXTREME DISTRESSING AND INCONSISTENCIES WITH YOUR PRINT



PROCESS PRINTING IS THE PRINTING OF A FULL SPECTRUM OF COLORS USING HALFTONE DOTS LAYERED OVER EACH OTHER.

THIS PROCESS IS USED WHEN SCREEN PRINTING A REALISTIC IMAGE ONTO YOUR GARMENTS. PROCESS PRINTING MAY ALWAYS BE USED WHEN THE COLORS NEEDED TO PRINT YOUR ARTWORK EXCEED THE MAX AMOUNT OF COLORS OFFERED BY YOUR PRINTER.

PROS

ALLOWS YOU TO PRINT REALISTIC IMAGES OF MULTIPLE COLORS

CONS

ARTWORK WILL REQUIRE
A COLOR SEPARATION FEE

PROCESS PRINTING REQUIRES THE USE OF SMALL HALFTONE DOTS RATHER THAN SOLID COLORED SHAPES.
